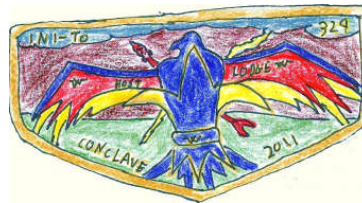
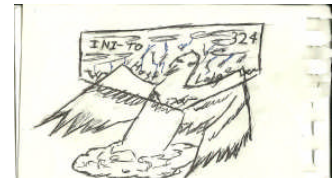

During Banquet Ray Capp will be speaking about where our order is headed next and about the new plans and visions. This is sure to be an unforgettable, historic banquet.

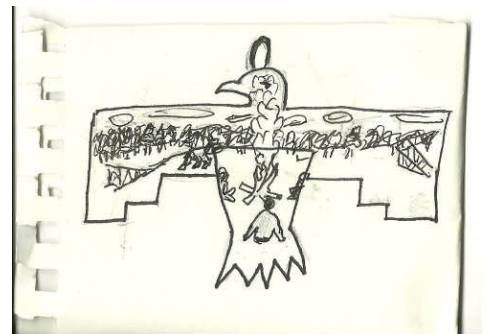
